

COVID-19 + Center: Admissions/Readmissions Supplemental Guidance under COVID-19 Pandemic Conditions

INSTRUCTIONS: This flowchart is intended to provide guidance for admitting and readmitting patients into a COVID-19 Positive Outbreak Center where the department of health HAS NOT imposed a ban on admissions.

COVID-19 Positive Outbreak Center

COVID Positive/ COVID Test Pending/ Screen Positive May Admit if:

Patient is **Readmitting**
to Prior Center
from Home or Hospital

Center is Prepared to Admit if:

- Private room or COVID+ bed availability
- PPE on-hand
- Staffing levels, and
- Hour of day for admission

ensure ability to
immediately implement
effective transmission

Patient given verbal
notification of presence of
Coronavirus in Center and
provides advised consent

Patient is **New Admission** to a
COVID-19 Positive Center
where:

- Genesis CMO, CNO,
SVPO/CO have
designated center to be
open for New
Admissions

Patient given verbal
notification of presence of
Coronavirus in Center and
provides advised consent

COVID Negative or Screen Negative May Not Admit Unless:

Patient is **Readmitting** to Prior
Center from Home or Hospital

Alternative COVID-naïve Center is
Offered and Declined

Patient given verbal notification of
presence of Coronavirus in Center
and provides advised consent

New Admissions To Centers With Resolved COVID-19 Outbreaks and Admission Bans in Place:

- Approval is received from DPH to remove the imposed admission ban, **AND**
- Genesis CMO, CNO, SVPO/SVPCO and Infection Control have:
 - o completed a 7-day and 14-day check-in process, and
 - o authorized Center to resume admissions.
